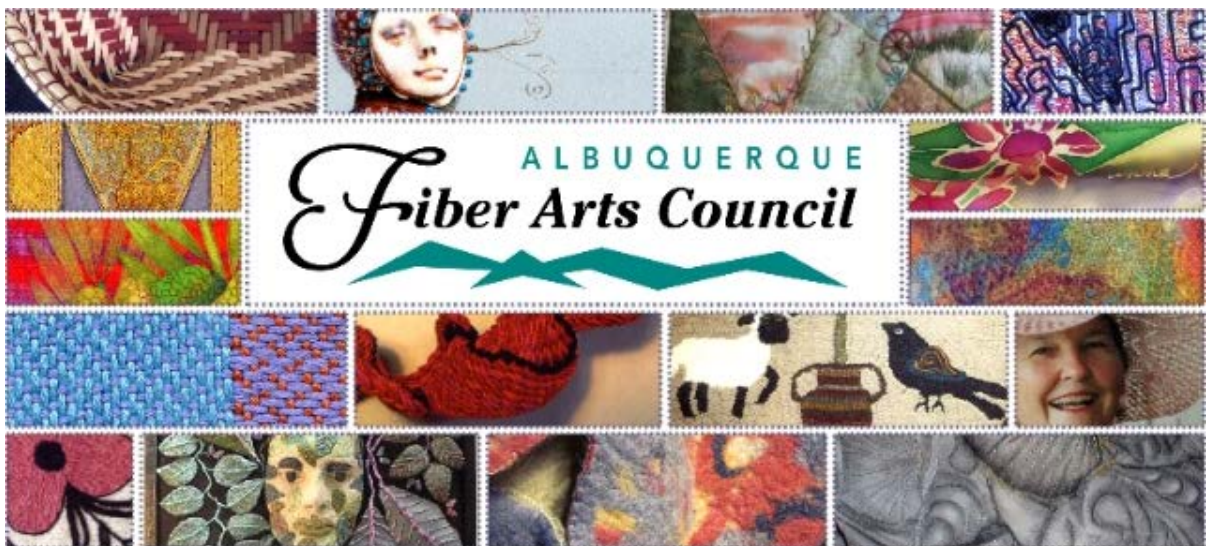

## **Susan's Legacy**

The Albuquerque Fiber Arts Fiesta committee voted to select Susan's Legacy as the local, non-profit organization to support at the 2017 Fiesta. Members of our 19 guilds are making gift items (We're calling them Doo-Dahs!) to be made available to everyone who makes a donation to the charity during Fiesta. For each \$5 donation, the donor can select a handmade Doo-Dah from the table. In past years this has been quite a popular destination at Fiesta because visitors are aware of the quality of the items that are available. No one leaves with only one Doo-Dah! Susan's Legacy is also listed on Amazon Smile. With your Amazon purchases you can select Susan's Legacy as your charity and a donation will be made to them from Amazon-- at no cost to you. It's a win-win for everyone. You don't need to wait for Fiesta to assist Susan's Legacy through your generous donations.

**Susan's Legacy is a small, non-profit agency that provides intensive recovery support for women with co-occurring mental health and addictive disorders. The goal for clients is to move from surviving to thriving as self-sufficient, contributing community members. Clients must be committed to recovery and actively engage in the services provided by SL to support the goals of becoming mentally stable and substance free. Findings from the National Institute on Drug Abuse show that effectively treating addiction includes a long-term approach that provides treatment for the multiple needs of clients. Susan's Legacy addresses these needs by providing case management, individual mental health and addiction counseling, and psycho-educational groups. [Susan's Legacy](#) provides services to clients free of charge. Because clients don't pay for these services, Susan's Legacy is dependent upon grants, donations, and fundraising to continue its work with co-occurring women.**
