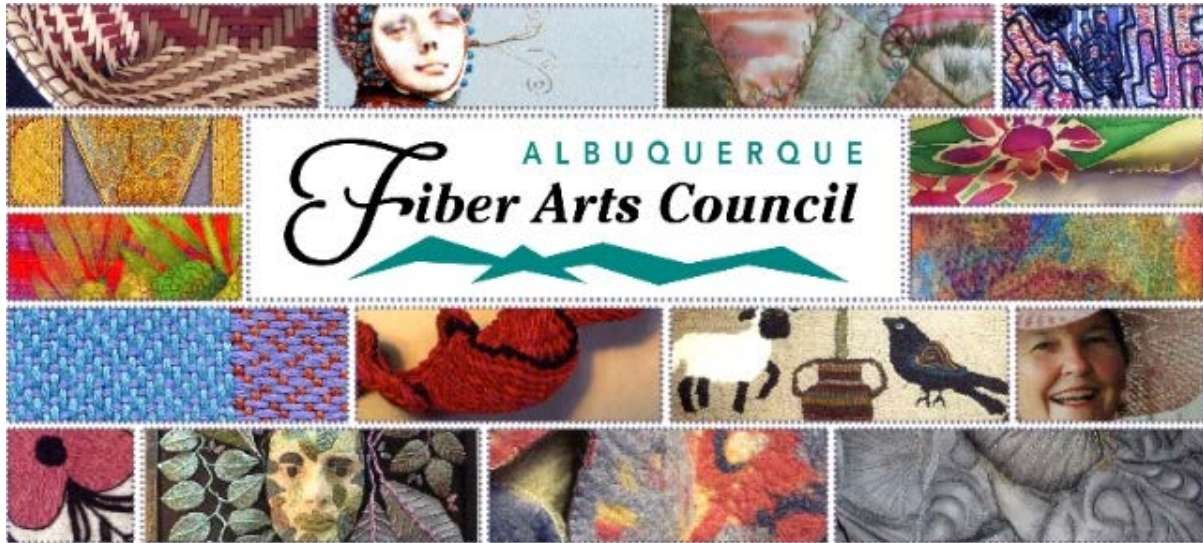


Take a breath...

We presented Mary's award at the All-Guild Presidents' Round-table on September 28th. Mary is using her scholarship award to help offset the cost of attending and taking classes at The Association of Traditional Hooking Artists (ATHA) biennial meeting, the largest rug hooking event in the US (held in Ohio this year).

She will be attending several classes and will be presenting an education program at three monthly AWAG meetings to share what she has learned. She will also be making herself available for individual coaching to anyone who wants more detail from the classes she attended.
